From the Secretary's Desk

Greetings Brethren from the secretary's desk and Happy New Year. I hope everyone had a blessed Christmas and was able to spend quality time with your families.

Brethren just a reminder, dues are due and payable by January 1, 2019. Dues are now \$100.00. If you have not sent yours in, please take time and mail them in.

On Sunday January 13th we will be having our monthly pancake breakfast. Brethren, this is a monthly fundraiser that supports the maintenance and upkeep of the lodge. Come out and enjoy a great breakfast, fellowship, and help with the cooking and cleanup. We would really appreciate all the help we can get.

Each year, more than 250,000 Americans die from sudden cardiac arrest. According to medical experts, the key to survival is timely initiation of a "chain of survival", including CPR, (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation). Because of recent technological advances a portable lifesaving device, an "automated defibrillator" or "AED" has recently become an important medical tool. Trained non-medical personnel can use these simplified electronic machines to treat a person in cardiac arrest. The AED device "guides the user through the process by audible or visual prompts without requiring any discretion or judgment." The American Heart Association notes that at least 20,000 lives could be saved annually by prompt use of AEDs. Ultimately, with broad deployment of AEDs among trained responders, as many as 50,000 deaths due to sudden cardiac arrest could be prevented each year. Recently, the lodge purchased one of these devices at a cost of \$1,300.00. W.B. Ross Anderson headed up the committee on the research and purchase of the device and asked several individuals for donations which responded in a receipt of \$900.00 to go towards the device. We would like to thank all that donated. Since this was an unbudgeted expense, if anyone would like to donate to the lodge to cover the additional \$400.00 of the cost, it would gladly be accepted. Several brethren have gone through a training course on how to use the device. However, we hope it never has to be used.

Brethren, we still have not had a brother step up for the Junior Deacon position. If you are interested, please let the Worshipful Master know.
